
# Corvias Budget Book S027: Surrattsville High School

The MMBR device will be treating 12,340 square feet of impervious area with a maximum drainage area of about 20,000 square feet. # RECENT AWARD: Baden Branch Library

The Prince George's County Memorial Library System recently awarded NARDI Construction their Baden Branch Library project. This project involves the interior renovation of a 4,900 square foot existing stand-alone building with minor exterior work. Work includes demolition, partition walls, new doors & frames, hardware, ceiling, flooring finishes, millwork, HVAC upgrade, electrical systems, LED lighting, plumbing, fire alarm, and complete AVIT, security & control access system. Exterior work consists of full window opening replacement, roof replacement, minor concrete and sidewalk repairs as well as exterior canopy replacement.

On September 15th, the official ribbon cutting ceremony was held for the medical unit for the Prince George's County
Department of Corrections. NARDI was awarded this contract with the County for the new state-of-the-art 22,263 square foot facility.
