New Corvias Project



Oakland's Stream Restoration



Our newest Corvias Prince George's County Stormwater project to break ground is the Oakland's Stream Restoration. This 253 acre project involves the construction of a new stable stream channel that can safely convey a 100-year storm within the existing incised stream channel. The stream channel will also be stabilized to prevent further erosion of Sediment.

Demo of the existing facility and construction of a new 22,263 SF 2 story facility. The new facility will include exam rooms, isolation cells, medical treatment areas, upgraded security, medical offices, and a full vegetative roof.

Construction of a vehicle security checkpoint including exterior excavation & demo, roadway widening & resurfacing, concrete & barriers, guard booth, canopy, electrical & lighting, landscaping, storm drain improvements, signage & striping and installation of a SWM bioswale facility.

Fit-Out of the Second Floor of the existing building and renovations to the First Floor Hearing Room.

The Cyber Lab included construction of new interior partitions with alterations of existing HVAC and electrical and installation of new finish flooring. The Visitor Center included an expansion of the reception area, renovation of conference rooms, new partitions, alterations of existing HVAC, electrical & plumbing, new flooring & ceiling and a new interior vestibule storefront.
