

## Recent Prince George's County Awards: Circuit Court Security Check Point & Circuit Court Second Floor Marbury Wing Refresh



NARDI was recently awarded two new projects for Prince George's County, the Circuit Court Security Check Point & Circuit Court Second Floor Marbury Wing Refresh. The Security Check Point project is the construction of a vehicle security checkpoint including exterior excavation & demo, roadway widening & resurfacing, concrete & barriers, guard booth, canopy, electrical & lighting and associated site work. The 2nd Floor Marbury Wing Refresh will consist of 7 phases of work involving renovations to various departments, lounges, restrooms and chambers.

### Oakland and Brier Mill Streams



Two of NARDI's current Clean Water Partnership projects include the Oaklands ES Stream Restoration and The Brier Mill Run Stream Restoration retrofit projects. The purpose of these stream restoration projects is to create a new stable stream channel that can safely convey a 100-year storm within the existing incised stream channel. At Brier Mill Run, a multi-stage channel will be constructed in order to shift the channel within the right of way, to minimize the clearing of existing trees. Both stream channels will also be stabilized to prevent further erosion of sediment. These projects have educational signage posted during construction to communicate the purpose of the proposed projects and planned water quality benefits.

### Social Security Administration



NARDI Construction completed the build-out of the 10,500 sf Social Security Administration offices in Reston Virginia earlier this month. This construction included several base building modifications such as adding on to the 2nd Floor of the building, removing the loading dock and enclosing the front entrance to create additional interior tenant space. The offices included a large training facility, conference rooms and open office areas as well as 18 custom interview stations.

Corenic and NARDI teamed up to bid on the Shady Glen Fire & EMS Station. Our team was awarded the project as the low bidder at bid submission. The scope of this project includes a new 14,300 sf Pre-Engineered Metal Building used for Cadet Recruit training. Also included is a 14,000 gsf 1 story, 4 bay drive through Fire Station. The apparatus bay (7,200 sf) is a double stacked drive through arrangement. The Fire House itself is 6,800 sf and includes 10 bunks to accommodate male and female firefighters. Construction is set to start by the end of the year.
